# Articulation Implementation Agreement Document Review

The Chief Academic Officer shall be the representative of the collaborating institution and shall be responsible for reviewing and incorporating any changes into subsequent agreements, and for

1. The purpose of this agreement is to establish a framework for the articulation of courses between the two institutions. This agreement shall be effective from the date of signing until the date of the next review.

2. The articulation process shall be managed by the Chief Academic Officer of the collaborating institution. The process shall include the following steps: (a) identification of courses for articulation; (b) review of course descriptions; (c) determination of articulation status; and (d) implementation of the articulation agreement.

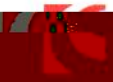
